SITE CARE:

- Clean skin around catheter. Cover the exit site with occlusive dressing and leave extensions, clamps, and caps exposed for access by staff.
 - Catheter is compatible with: · Bactroban ointment, 2% Mupirocin, polyethylene glycol ointment, N.F.
 - · Silvadene cream, 1% silver sulfadiazine

Wound dressings must be kept clean and dry.

- 10% Povidone-lodine Ointment

 - · ChloroPrep, 2% Chlorhexidine d-Digluconate + 70% Isopropanol (Isopropyl Alcohol)
 - · Anasept, 0.057% Sodium Hypochlorite · 70% Alcohol

CATHETER MAINTENANCE: Flush and lock catheter according to your institutional policy. CAUTION: Patients must not swim, shower, or soak dressing while bathing. If profuse perspiration or accidental wetting compromises adhesion of dressing.

the medical or nursing staff must change the dressing under sterile conditions.

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
